How to Dress for Your Work Day

- Closed toed shoes (work boots or sneakers)
- Layers you don't mind getting dirty (or painted)
- Long pants (and long sleeves) without cuffs preferred nothing baggy
- Protective facemask that covers mouth and nose
- Little or no jewelry
- No dangling strings
- Hair tied back





What You Should Bring

Stay safe and hydrated!

In the event you do not have your own, Habitat will have water, bug spray, rain ponchos, sunscreen, and protective equipment.

Lunch will not be provided, unless arranged by your volunteer group.

- Lunch and water bottle
- Facemask that covers your mouth and nose
- Work gloves, safety glasses, tool belt (if you have them)
- Positive attitude, willingness to get dirty

When You Arrive

(8:15 – 8:30 am)

- Greeted by site supervisor, get a nametag
- Sign in and sign the liability waiver (if not done previously)
- 8:30 am KICKOFF! (Learn about the Habitat Oakland mission and community)
- Safety briefing
- Job assignments and PPE preparation



Typical Construction Tasks

- Building walls
- Framing
- Priming and painting
- Drywall repair
- Roofing
- Siding
- Flooring
- Tiling
- Installing cabinets/appliance/fixtures
- Hanging blinds/other finishing items
- Landscaping
- Site cleanup

Typical Day

Volunteers arrive, 8:15 – 8:30 am

Kickoff, 8:30 am

Lunch break around noon

Site cleanup, 3:00 – 3:30 pm

Site Supervisors will help all experience levels have a productive build day!





Remember:

Follow safety guidelines for use of ladders and tools.

Be aware of your surroundings! Check for uneven ground, wires (above and below), and for people carrying large objects. Please take breaks for rest, water, food, or bathroom, as needed throughout the day.

Please talk to the site supervisor if you are not comfortable with a task.
